

# Russ Will Leave Harbin, Chinese Reds Take Over

A Chinese government spokesman conceded the rich north Manchurian city of Harbin to the communists today but insisted that the Russians get out of the southern port of Dairen, which so far is not on the Red army's schedule of withdrawals.

The spokesman, Minister of Information K. C. Wu, declared that Chinese communists were "already in Harbin" from which the Russians are scheduled to withdraw by the end of the day.

Wu said he had no information on the situation at Dairen "but Dairen is a part of China and we expect the Russians to withdraw from all Manchuria before the end of the month, as they agreed."

Dairen became a free port under the Chinese-Russian treaty of last August.

Several sources reported that

Chinese government planes, trying to land at Harbin to evacuate tarrying government officials, found the airport already taken over by the communists. The planes returned to Mukden, one of the few government-controlled Manchurian cities, without the officials. Earlier in the week, 81 administrators sent in to Harbin weeks ago, had flown to Mukden.

Sage Jorgensen, the Danish consul who flew out of Harbin only yesterday, told Associated Press photographer Julian Willson in Mukden that Harbin residents would welcome the arrival of the communists. He said the citizens feared an outbreak of robbery and looting if the communists didn't take over because the government garrison there was too small to assume control.

**Take Harbin**  
Communist leaders said several days ago they would take Harbin as soon as the Russians withdrew.

An Associated Press dispatch from Peiping said that four planes sent to Harbin yesterday to evacuate officials—the number was not reported—found communists had taken over the air fields. The pilots said the city appeared, from the air, to be in confusion. There were no details.

Lt. Gen. Chao Chia-hsiang, chief of staff of the government's northeastern command, said "The generalissimo (Chiang Kai-shek) is very concerned about the situation." Chao flew to Peiping from Chungking yesterday and expected to proceed to Mukden.

## Notables Name 'Mott Basin'

ASTORIA, Ore., April 25 (AP)—The naval basin which will berth 500 naval auxiliary vessels was dedicated by Mrs. James Mott, Salem, in honor of her late husband, in sunny ceremonies here yesterday.

A delegation of congressmen, including all Oregon's representatives, saw Mott basin officially named for the Oregon representative who fought 14 years for development of Astoria as a naval base.

"This is a memorial to James Mott, but Jim needs no memorial," Rep. W. Sterling Cole (R-NY) said in the principal dedicatory address. "We shall always remember his foresight, his wisdom, his inspiration... no man has contributed more to the navy for either war or peace than did James Mott."

Capt. S. P. Jenkins, commander of the Columbia river group, 19th fleet, told the dedication audience that the naval vessels berthed at Mott basin can be activated immediately whenever needed.
