Streamlined All-America Army Sought

WASHINGTON, May 7 (AP)—An inter-American military system streamlined into a closely knit striking force appeared today to be President Truman's ultimate goal in asking congress to perpetuate this country's wartime hemisphere role.

Such a force—entirely equipped with United States arms, its individual units organized along U. S. staff lines and led by officers trained in this country—would be ready for instant action against any future aggressor.

Behind that request is the history of several Latin American nations which over a long period relied on German artillery when it first began to train for its overseas assignment.

If congress goes along with Mr. Truman the first result is expected to be a number of agreements with individual countries to continue the program of military assistance formerly rendered by this country under lend-lease and other wartime arrangements.

Eventually, however, the requested law would permit the United States to play its full roll in carrying out the projected inter-American defense alliance, scheduled to be drawn up at a conference in Brazil some-time this year.

Churchill Seeks Harmony With USSR As Peace Basis

LONDON, May 7 (AP)—Winston Churchill declared today "the supreme hope and prime endeavor" toward achieving peace "is to reach a good and faithful understanding with Soviet Russia through the agency and organization of the United Nations."

"Only in this way can catastrophe be avoided," he said. The wartime prime minister spoke at a ceremony giving him the freedom of the city of Westminster, the section of London embracing the houses of parliament and Westminster Abbey. He spoke at Church House, where the first session of the United Nations security council was held.

Churchill asked the world to ponder "what happens if the United Nations themselves are sundered by an awful schism, a clash of ideologies and passions?"

"Failure to find the answer," he said, "may lead the whole human race into a new period of misery, slaughter and abasement more agonizing and fatal than those which have twice been endured in the lifetime of most of us."

He called on "the English-speaking world and the western democracies of Europe to move together in creating a true fellowship with Russia."

"I hope in this world organization there will be a strong France and a revived Italy," he said. "France, after all her troubles, may yet lead Europe into peace and plenty."

CIO Gets Test At Polls Today

Primaries in four states rang up the off-year election curtain today, and in two of them the CIO political action committee sought to demonstrate its continued effectiveness at the polls.

Top interest centered in the four-cornered race for the democratic senatorial nomination in Ohio and the two-man contest for the district Alabama house seat—both featured by PAC activity.

Indiana and Florida also held primaries. In all, the four states will select candidates for two senate and 49 house seats in congress, two gubernatorial nominations also are at stake.

Advance indications pointed to a generally light vote. Ohio, Indiana and Florida reported less than lukewarm interest on

the part of the voters. In Alabama, however, heavy registration, particularly by war veterans, led to expectations of a record primary vote.

The Alabama and Florida balloting was noteworthy because negroes were voting officially statewide for the first time in the hitherto "white" primaries. But neither state expected much of a negro vote.

Politicians gave their main attention to the showing of PAC in Ohio and Alabama. They

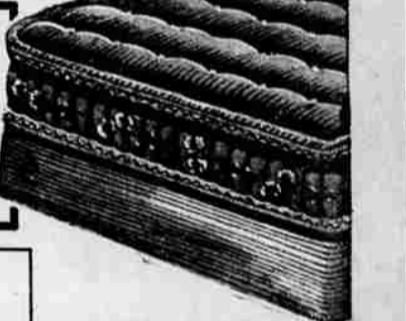
