

## Century Group To Seek Funds

Underwriting the pageant for the Centennial celebration will be the next move of the association and will get underway as soon as a finance committee is appointed, it was announced today.

Within the next few days the committee will be announced and it will be the work of the members to secure signers of notes for optional amounts to cover estimated expenses totaling \$15,000. Notes will not be cashed unless necessary and it is not expected that guarantors will be asked to pay out, association executives stated.

Sources of income will be ticket sales and concession fees. Any surplus over and above expenses, would be turned over to the Klamath museum fund, according to by-laws of the association.

Plans are to engage a manager to take full charge of the celebration which will be held this fall. Outlying communities are invited to participate and anyone with script ideas is invited to submit them to the Klamath County chamber of commerce. These may be in rough form with historical incidents and dates accurate.

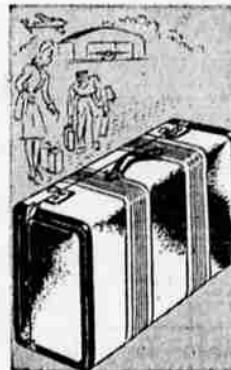

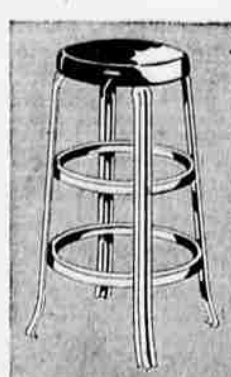
