

Joe Carson To Speak At Democratic Rally

Joe Carson, former mayor of Portland and one of the democratic party leaders of the state, will be principal speaker at an open house and rally to be held here May 16.

Carson, a veteran of World War II, was prominently mentioned as a possible candidate for governor of Oregon this year but declined the nomination.

The rally here, scheduled for the night before the primary elections, is being designed for particular interest to war veterans but all persons interested in party politics and the democratic party are invited to attend.

E. P. (Pat) Ivory, democratic national committeeman, is to be master of ceremonies for the evening. W. Lamar Townsend, local attorney who is unopposed as the democratic nomination to congress from the Oregon second district, will also be among the speakers.

On the entertainment side of the program, the four Mahoney sisters have scheduled several vocal numbers, accompanied by Baldy Evans, and a number of other musical acts are also being arranged.

GI Smokers Blamed For Forest Fires

SEATTLE, May 9 (AP)—Cigarettes tossed by soldiers out of windows of army troop trains have caused menacing fires in the city's Cedar River watershed the past few days, Water Superintendent W. C. Morse reported today to the city council.

A crew of 20 men fought for hours yesterday to stop a fire which swept through 10 acres of second-growth timber between Landsburg and Cedar Falls before it was controlled, he said. Several smaller fires were quickly detected and put out.

Demand For Power May Exceed Supply

PORTLAND, Ore., May 9 (AP)—Northwest development and demand for electric power may outpace supply of materials until 1950, S. C. Schultz, Bonneville chief engineer, told the Columbia basin interagency committee here.

He said materials shortage has already hampered delivery of power needs in some districts despite the war-end cutbacks of shipyard and aircraft industries.

Wheat Bonus Out In Klamath County

The government bonus on wheat is not effective in Klamath county. Farmers in Klamath county will not benefit from the government bonus of 30 cents per bushel offered for delivery of wheat before May 25, for government purchase, unless they are willing to haul or ship wheat to accredited warehouses or warehouses approved as receiving stations for such wheat. There are no such warehouses in Klamath county. Klamath county is recognized as a deficiency area for wheat production and

has at present a local ceiling of \$1.73845 per bushel that may be paid by dealers to producers of wheat.

Wheat hauled or shipped from the county to surplus wheat producing areas where such warehouses are accredited or approved would come under terminal market ceilings of \$1.668 per bushel. This change of ceiling prices plus the cost of transporting or shipping would mean that the farmer would make little or no gain by exporting his wheat. As Klamath county does not produce sufficient wheat for her own needs there is no point in exporting wheat which would have to be replaced by wheat imports from other areas. It is for this reason that the emergency wheat purchase program offered by the government has practical application only in surplus wheat producing areas.
