As a citizen and voter of Klamath County, Oregon, I wish to express my opinion on the present crisis confronting every person in the United States.

I URGE and DEMAND that immediate legislative steps be taken to control any coercive force which threatens or may threaten public welfare and health or national reconversion by willfully obstructing or restricting full scale production of vital and essential products.

Since V-J Day, nine months ago, innumerable and unnecessary strikes brought about by political aspirations have threatened our national security. Shall a handful of greedy men striving for power and political prominence cause millions of innocent families to suffer?

The steel, the automobile, the electrical, the lumber and now the coal industries have been struck, preventing vitally needed goods from reaching the consumers. Who is directing the welfare of this nation—the people or a few labor union heads?
