VANCOUVER, B. C. May 21 (CP) — Two seastruck girls sailed away from Vancouver tonight as members of the crew of the Norwegian freighter Phalar. The girls, believed to be the first British Columbia females to sign aboard a deep sea merchant vessel, are Miss Doris Vierin, 22, of Sullivan Station and Miss Mary Peck, 23, of New Westminster.

It all started when they discovered there were two vacant berths aboard the Phalar. Being members of the Canadian Seamen's union (AFL) they applied for jobs as stewardesses. Captain O. Bjornagaard and the crew voiced hearty approval. The girls got the jobs.

Stassen Flays Administration

CHICAGO, May 21 (AP) — Removal of the secretaries of labor and commerce and the stabilization director was urged by Harold E. Stassen, former governor of Minnesota, as "men having major responsibility in the failure of the administration" to meet the emergency problems of reconversion.

In an address to the Inland Daily Press association, Stassen, a republican, urged President Truman "to promptly call a major economic conference consisting of representatives of the major economic groups, of the best of the nation's economists, and of the leadership of both parties."

"I urge that the economic conference recommend the basis in which the entire economy can be promptly adjusted to the new level now irrevocably created by the 18 1/2 cent steel formula, and present the plain-spoken basis for holding the line at that new level."

Soldiers Stoned By Egyptian Mob

ALEXANDRIA, May 21 (AP) — Two British soldiers and a military policeman were stoned by an Egyptian crowd yesterday after a British truck collided with a streetcar, injuring four persons among whom were three Egyptian policemen.

The British were rescued by two truckloads of special Egyptian police.

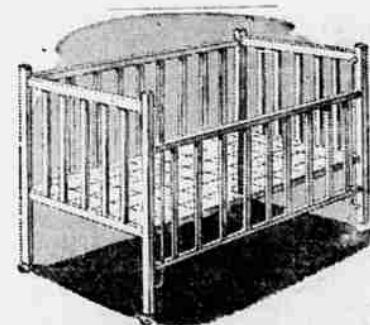
