

# Camp Fire Girls Outline Big Program For Summer

Plans for the Camp Fire Girls summer camp at their Lake of the Woods camp, Camp Esther Applegate, have been completed and registrations are being accepted for girls who are Blue Birds, Camp Fire and Horizon club girls.

Camp sessions will be July 14 through July 21 and July 21 through July 28. Blue Birds, the seven to 10-year-old girls, may attend the second session, July 21 through 28, and the Camp Fire and Horizon girls may attend the first session, second session or for the entire two-week period.

A complete program for each age group has been planned. Ethyl Bremer, executive secretary, will direct camp and the staff is made up of women who are specifically trained to assist the girls in the craft or activity which they will direct.

Girls will live in floored tents which house four to six and will sleep on steel cots. Each small group of tents is supervised by counselors who live in the same area. Meals are served and general indoor activities are held in the lodge which is large enough to accommodate all the girls.

# Flying School Open To Vets

The Oregon Aircraft Service school, Allen Mocabee, manager, announces flight courses for veterans who may enroll under the GI educational program.

There will be three instructors, in addition to Mocabee, at the school which at the present time offers the private flying course, issuing a private license upon completion. Later, Mocabee plans to give a commercial course with commercial license, instructor course with instructor rating, instrument course with instrument rating and twin-engine course with rating.

The course in private flying, approved by the civil aeronautics authority, will take about 60 days and includes 35 hours' flight time and 24 hours' ground time. The ground school takes in meteorology, civil air regulations, navigation and airplane theory flight.

Veterans interested in this course should see Patrick Kilby or Zeno Dent at the veterans' contact bureau, basement of the courthouse, to get availability certificates entitling them to take flight training. All information on veterans' allowances is available at this office on the educational program plan.

Physical examinations for the course and flight examinations upon completion of the course will be paid for by the veteran, according to present arrangement.
