

Veteran Groups Project Basin-Wide Organization

Sixteen representatives from veterans organizations, including Tulelake, Malin, Lakeview and Klamath Falls, met at the Winema hotel Wednesday night to organize a Basin Area Veterans Council. It was voted by those present to complete organization and Olney Rudd, commander of Tulelake Legion Post 164, was elected chairman. Walter Thoma, Pelican Post 1383 of the VFW, vice chairman, and Carter E. Fetsch, Lakeview Legion post, secretary-treasurer. After much discussion, it was voted that the officers draft a resolution containing the objectives of the organization, to be presented to each veterans' group for ratification, and further that copies of the resolution be forwarded to congressmen and senators from Oregon and California.

Those present agreed that every vets' club in the southern Oregon and northern California area be invited to participate and that each group be asked to elect one delegate and one alternate, for purposes of conducting the affairs of the council. A meeting was set for July 10 at 7:30 at the Winema hotel for final organization and outline of procedure. Each person present was delegated to seek approval of his individual organization, and letters, outlining policy, will be sent to each club not represented Wednesday night.

Due to the need for immediate action, the group, voting as individual veterans, voted to endorse senate bill 1672, calling for retention of certain buildings at the WRA camp in Tulelake by the reclamation commission for use of homesteaders and lessees of government in that area, as homes, until permanent structures could be erected.
