

House Passes Furlough Pay

WASHINGTON, June 11 (AP)—The house today passed and sent to the senate legislation giving past and present enlisted men and women pay for furlough time they did not receive while in service.

The legislation sets, as a standard, two and one-half days of furlough time each month and permits the accumulation of not more than 120 days for which payment must be made in cash.

Payments are computed at the rate of base pay received at the time of discharge, plus allowances of not less than 70 cents a day. House military committee members have estimated approximately 15,000,000 service people would receive an average of \$250 under the legislation.

Personnel already discharged would be paid immediately upon their own certification that they are entitled to payments. The amount they receive would depend on the amount of accrued furlough time they certify they had at the time of discharge.
