

## Norblad Raps Nut Imports

WASHINGTON, June 20 (AP)—Rep. Norblad (R-Ore.) protested today to the state department and the UNRRA against importation of edible nuts from European countries.

He said the imports were cutting into the income of American producers.

Norblad suggested famine areas from which the nuts were imported be required to use them as food, adding that in the last five months 38,000,000 pounds of edible nuts have been reached from European countries.

"The importation of filberts have increased 500 per cent this year over prewar imports," Norblad said. "The caloric content of filberts imported in the last six months is equivalent to the caloric content of 220,000 bushels of wheat."

## Remedy Asked For Nails, Wire

WASHINGTON, June 20 (AP)—Action by the office of price administration and the civilian production administration to solve the problem of shortage of nails and baling wire in Oregon was promised Senator Cordon (R-Ore.) today by the CPA.

The CPA wrote Cordon the two agencies were cooperating to remedy the situation and the plan probably would take the form of a price increase with assurance that there would be a production increase.

Acting Governor Howard Belton wrote Cordon the shortage of nails for fruit crates and the shortage of baling wire threatened a catastrophe in the state. He said a large amount of the state's agricultural products were shipped in crates or in bales and that unless sufficient supplies were forthcoming much fruit and many other products would be wasted.

## Idaho Convict Loses Race to Dying Wife

BOISE, Idaho, June 20 (AP)—An Idaho state prisoner serving a one to 10 year sentence for forgery lost a race with death yesterday as he attempted to reach his dying wife at a Baker, Oregon hospital.

Elmer Achele, granted an emergency 10-day reprieve by the governor, boarded the first train for Baker. He arrived three hours after his wife Rachel died of injuries suffered in an automobile accident. She had been en route from Walla Walla, Wash., to visit her husband at the prison.

## Year-Around Tuna Packing Planned

ASTORIA Ore., June 20 (AP)—Year-around tuna packing will be made possible by shipment here of tuna from Costa Rica, the Van Camp Packing company reported today.

The company said shipment of 40 to 50 tons of tuna a month by sea and rail will enable the cannery to employ 250 workers on an annual basis instead of for three months a year on locally caught albacore tuna.
