SEATTLE, June 20 (AP)—The government disclosed today that the wife of a trial engineer in a Seattle shipyard will be one of the witnesses for the prosecution in the espionage trial of Lt. Nicolai G. Redin, the erstwhile Seattle representative of

the Soviet purchasing commission. The trial is scheduled to start Tuesday. Redin has denied his guilt.
