

# Youths Held In Lakeview For Thefts

Two Klamath Falls youths, one 16 and the other 15, are being held in Lakeview after being apprehended by state police following the theft of a car here and one in Lakeview.

Juvenile Officer Spec Murray said that the boys would be returned to Klamath Falls.

They are believed to have taken a 1937 DeSoto from the Harold Dye used car lot, 6th and Oak, Saturday night or Sunday, and driven it to Lakeview, where the car was abandoned.

Then in Lakeview the youths allegedly picked up another car, an Oldsmobile, and were driving it back toward Klamath Falls Monday night when state police chased them down and saw them ditch the car.

The boys were caught hiding in the brush. On their way to Lakeview, the boys are said to have stopped off in Bly and swiped a license tag from another vehicle for their car.

The DeSoto was not missed by Dye from his lot until the car was recovered in Lakeview and city police here began tracing a statement given by the boys to Lakeview officials that the car had been taken from a lot at 8th and Oak.

Murray said that both boys were well known to juvenile officials here, and that the older had twice been sent to the Boys Industrial school at Woodburn for stealing cars.

# 'Manhunt' Gets Wide Interest
