

# James Roosevelt Heads Democrats In California

SACRAMENTO, July 22 (AP)—James Roosevelt, former marine colonel and eldest son of the late president, assumed his duties today as chairman of the California State Democratic Central committee to which he was elected after a strenuous contest in the committee.

Roosevelt won the fight in the caucus of the southern California delegation by a 200 to 107 vote over Thomas Scully, Los Angeles democratic leader.

Roosevelt was supported by Will Rogers Jr., son of the late humorist. Rogers is the democratic nominee for U. S. senator to oppose Senator W. F.

# George White Free On Bail

SAN DIEGO, Calif., July 22 (AP)—George White, 52, Hollywood and New York theatrical producer of "Scandals" girl shows, was free on bail here today after his arrest on suspicion of causing the traffic deaths of a newlywed pair and failing to stop and give aid.

He was accused by State Traffic Patrol Officer Luther M. Hake, in the county jail booking, of negligent homicide and felonious failure to stop his borrowed automobile.

White denied the charges last night at his hotel, telling newsmen that "the first I knew of the accident was when a motorcycle cop stopped me just outside of San Diego," Saturday night.

He was arrested ten miles from where Claude McLester Lee, 42, was killed and his bride, Leona Ann Osborne Lee, was fatally injured on highway 101 at 10:30 p. m. Saturday night.

The girl bride, who had married Lee only a few hours before at Tijuana, Mex., died at an Oceanside hospital at 10:30 a. m. yesterday.

# Airport Oil Contract Signed By Lakeview

LAKEVIEW, July 22 — The city council Saturday signed a five-year agreement with a major oil company for complete fuel service at the Lakeview airport, recently returned by the navy to the city of Lakeview under an interim permit. The airport is under the management of Dale Williams and Glen Plato.

Under the terms of the agreement, an 80-octane portable pump has been installed and 91-octane gasoline is also available. The city of Lakeview will receive two cents per gallon on all gasoline sold at the airport, as well as five cents on each gallon of oil.

# Lakeview Sets 'Klamath Day'

Saturday, July 27, has been named Klamath Day at the Lakeview airport presentation ceremonies, and plans are under way here to send airplanes to participate in the event.

Approximately 15 planes, possibly more, plan to attend the show, including Dr. C. V. Rugh, Pete Newbill, Elton At. Cliff Hogue, Lloyd Derby and Ray Byrnes flying their own ships and some nine to 11 ships from the three flying services, Shasta Cascade, Oregon and Walla.

Lloyd Derby, committee member, has asked that all flyers time their own flights, planning to arrive in Lakeview in time to circle the town twice and land at two o'clock in the afternoon.

Some 12,000 leaflets will be dropped by the flyers over Lakeview. The little brochures will be split between publicity for the coming centennial celebration on August 22, 23 and 24 and the Klamath Air Day event on August 1, when the first United mainliner will come into Klamath on a scheduled flight.
