

79th Congress Earmarks \$90 Million For Oregon; Klamath Work Included

WASHINGTON, July 25 (AP)—The second session of the 79th congress, now nearing adjournment, has appropriated more than \$90,000,000 for Oregon projects, including irrigation, flood control, a huge hydroelectric power dam and improvements in the Columbia river channel.

Senator Cordon (R-Ore.) rates congressional approval of and appropriations for Willamette valley projects as the session's most important work for Oregon. These would control the waters of the stream which in many seasons have done great flood damage.

The session approved appropriations of \$1,716,000 for construction of the Deschutes irrigation project, \$1,281,000 for the Klamath project and \$125,000 for the Owyhee project. It authorized \$2,000,000 to start work on the McNary dam across the Columbia river from Oregon to Washington, \$200,000 for improvement of the Columbia's channel from Vancouver, Wash., to Bonneville, \$1,700,000 for the Detroit dam on the Willamette, \$1,000,000 for the Meridian dam on the Willamette and \$450,000 for bank protection on the Willamette and tributaries.

Praised by Cordon
"These projects," Cordon said, "are of the greatest material value to the state of any action taken by this congress. The Willamette appropriations will protect the existing assets and the Deschutes and Klamath irrigation projects will add to the value of the state's assets."

"The McNary dam will provide future power which will be needed by the time the project is completed and the improvements in the Columbia river channel will increase its navigability. All in all I feel Oregon has fared well at the hands of this congress."

During the session both Cordon and Senator Morse (R-Ore.) were active in affairs of the senate. Cordon is a member of the appropriations committee and of the subcommittee which handled the interior department and war department civil functions bills.

Cordon and Morse took part in most major debates in the senate. Morse drew attention by his insistence that the senate vote on the fair employment practices bill and the anti-politician bill. He repeatedly told the senate there should be a rule that would prevent a filibuster from blocking legislation.

Feed Shortage Said Improved
WASHINGTON, July 25 (AP)—The poultry feed situation in Washington and Oregon is "much improved" and threatened liquidation of flocks of poultry has not materialized, N. E. Dodd, assistant secretary of agriculture, told Senator Mitchell (D-Wash.) today.

Dodd notified Mitchell late last month that 245 cars of feed were en route to the states.

Since then, Dodd said, 75 cars of oats and 57 cars of barley have been sent to 134 cars of corn byproducts ordered from Midwest processors.

The assistant secretary said that when the price of the corn byproducts was increased slightly on July 1 a number of the consignees cancelled their orders and the department was "somewhat in the dark" as to the number actually delivered.

"We were very anxious over the reported feed shortage," Dodd said, "and are relieved to find that the situation is much improved and that the threatened liquidation has not materialized."

Jobless Vets Few In State

SALEM, July 25 (AP)—Oregon veterans, who have received almost \$7,000,000 in GI benefits since V-J Day, have one of the lowest unemployment rates in the country, the state unemployment compensation commission said today.

About 46,000 of the state's 100,000 veterans have filed claims, but many never drew a check. About 5600 checks were paid out last week to veterans, compared with the peak of 15,000 in February.

The commission said that in some states, the rate of payment is two or three times that of Oregon.

Silas Gaiser, administrator of the commission, said: "Employers in this state have been most co-operative in hiring returning veterans, and we find that young men and women back from the armed forces are much more anxious to work than to draw a government allowance."

"These veterans are not depending entirely upon the employment offices to find suitable jobs, but they are going out after work on their own and are fitting nicely into our peacetime economy. Many of these young people have had little experience in the work-a-day world and we all can help them get their start."

Fire Destroys Motor Trucks
WALLA WALLA, July 25 (AP)—Fifteen motor trucks out of a fleet operated by Tausick & Kauffman, fuel and ice dealers, were destroyed in an industrial district fire that consumed their storage garage, an adjoining warehouse leased by Zellerbach Paper company and smaller structures and threatened the W. P. Fuller & Co. warehouse.

Several hundred telephone customers west of Walla Walla were deprived of service when a 303-strand cable was severed, and power services also were interrupted by the fire which required every available piece of equipment in the city and adjoining military installations.

Fire was discovered about 9 p. m. and brought under control by midnight. Damage was estimated at \$150,000, the property covering more than a half block and jumping a street into another block.
