

# Juveniles Held For Vandalism

Six boys, all 10 or 11 years old, have been questioned by juvenile officials concerning a break-in and vandalism at a storeroom at 319 S. Eldorado where police estimate several hundred dollars worth of barber supplies and equipment were damaged or destroyed.

Five of the boys are said to have admitted being in the storeroom at one time or another during the past several days.

Orval Evans, who resides at the address, called police last night when he found the storeroom on the back of his lot open. The equipment and supplies belong to M. C. Gleason, 1147 East.

Entry to the place had been made by climbing to the roof, then going down to a window on a rope and through the window. The boys, all of whom live in the neighborhood, were located by police for questioning.

# Two Harrisburg Men Killed In Collision

HARRISBURG, July 31 (AP)—Two Harrisburg men were fatally injured yesterday when their small truck was struck by a Southern Pacific freight train at a crossing north of here, Lemuel E. Nicholson, 64, was found dead in the wreckage and William Trachsel, 51, died in a hospital at Eugene.

No witnesses to the accident were reported but state police said farmers told them of seeing the truck turn off the highway to a farm road at a fairly high speed.
