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Snell Recommends Juvenile Institution

PORTLAND, Aug. 5 (AP)—A special institution for Oregon juveniles after a first crime conviction was recommended by Governor Snell in a radio broadcast last night.

Participating in "Report to the People," a radio program of station KEX, the governor said he would urge establishment of such an institution in his 1947 message to the legislature. Boys would be sent to a reception center immediately upon conviction for several weeks of study by a trained staff in order to determine whether they should be committed to a training school, the intermediate institution, or penitentiary.

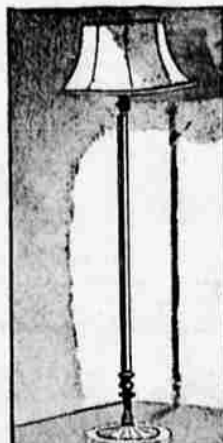

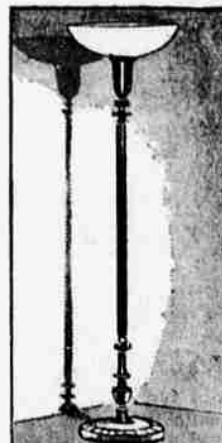
