GRAIN

CHICAGO, Aug. 15 (AP)—Corn dropped as much as 4 1/2 cents, the daily limit, at times today, when selling by commission houses touched off, stopping orders. New seasonal lows were recorded by both January and March contracts. Oats were weak.

Additional moisture over wide sections of the grain belt and issuance of detailed state crop reports asserting recent rains had virtually assured a record-breaking corn crop were responsible for some of the selling.

Another factor in the downturn was a department of agriculture statement placing rattle on feed in the corn belt on August 1 at 45 per cent less than a year ago.

Corn finished 3 1/2-3 3/4 lower, January 41.23 1/2, and oats were off 1/4-1/2. August 74 1/2, December barley sold at 31.25, off 1/2.
