

Jobless Pay Claim Drop Predicted

Claim leads for unemployment compensation is not expected to be so great this winter as last, according to the Oregon State Employment service offices here. Claims are now coming in, due to seasonal shutdown of some industries, but they are not in such numbers as prevailed a year ago.

Jack Almeter, office manager, said that practically all war-time industries have now either closed or converted to peacetime output, and war workers have either adjusted themselves to a new job or have removed themselves entirely from the labor market. Most of the men and women among the veteran group have found their niche, and are working this winter at a job or going to school.

The November report of the employment office gives 929 as the number of persons out of work in this area, including 209 women.

In November, 203 written applications for work were received at the employment office. Some 466 persons were referred to jobs and 298 placed. Written applications from veterans totaled 60.

Reporting on employment trends in 80 establishments, Almeter said 3206 persons were employed there in November, as compared with 5594 two months ago.

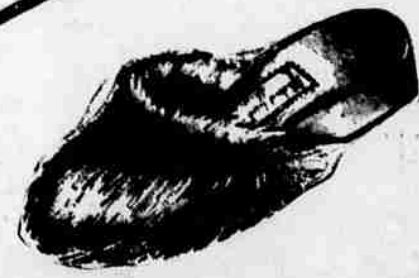
