

Fulbright Again Proposes That Truman Resign Post

WASHINGTON, Dec. 12 (AP)—Senator J. William Fulbright, (Ark.) credited President Truman today with a "very good job" in handling the coal strike crisis but clung to his recommendation that the chief executive resign in favor of a republican.

Despite a barrage of criticism from both fellow democrats and republicans, the 41-year-old lawmaker said he still is convinced that Mr. Truman should step down "for the good of the country and for the good of his party."

Fulbright, former Oxford scholar and university president, first advanced his proposal the day after the November 3 election in which the republicans swept to control of congress.

Mr. Truman himself brushed aside any comment, but the White House made it clear the president had no intention of quitting.

"My suggestion is not a reflection on anyone's integrity, patriotism, or anything else," the senator told a reporter today. "It would merely correct an obvious defect in our present system which has resulted when the president is a member of one party and the majority of congress another."

As for Mr. Truman's role in the coal crisis, Fulbright declared: "I think President Truman did a very good job in convincing John L. Lewis that he meant business and was not going to give in. I certainly think that was well handled."

However, the Arkansas senator continued, unless the president retires in favor of a republican, these things are in prospect:

1. There will be no cooperation between the republican congress and the democratic administration, and the next two years will be spent in "squabbling, investigations and attempts to show the democratic party is no good."

2. The republicans probably will win the 1948 election, and democratic strength in congress may decline to the same level the republicans sank to at the peak of the new deal.

3. Mr. Truman may leave office in 1948 under much the same circumstances as when President Hoover stepped out in 1932 after trying in vain to cooperate with democratic congressional majorities for two years.

NEWPORT Ore., Dec. 12 (AP)—The fishing schooner Etta May sank off Yaquina bar last night after an engine room explosion sent flames spreading over the 54-foot craft, but the crew of three was rescued.

The Etta May had put out with a cargo of potatoes for Alaska, where the captain, Philip Bowden, planned to fish next spring. Bowden was burned but other crew members, Russell Wheeler, Portland, and George Schanck, Toledo, escaped injury.

Hundreds of persons lined the beach for an hour as the schooner burned and the fishing boat Boris, captained by Ivor Anquell, went alongside and took the three men off.
