

Week-End Wrecks Kill 10 In State

Week-end traffic crashes—one of them fatal to eight—took a total of ten lives on Oregon's rain-drenched highways.

Mrs. Mabel Anna Amacher, 60, Portland, died in a three-car pile-up on the Ross Island bridge Saturday. South of Oregon City, Lester Doryland, Mulino, was thrown from his car when it skidded out of control. Members of his family, starting a search when he failed to appear, found the man dead on the road.

Eight young people were killed in a head-on crash of their automobile with a Greyhound bus north of Eugene Saturday night in the worst highway tragedy in Lane county history.

Six passengers in the bus were sent to the hospital and 14 others treated for minor injuries. The bus driver, Elmer Haycraft, was the most seriously hurt. He

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suffered a fractured jaw and nose and facial cuts.

Seven of the young people were killed outright and the eighth, a girl, died before she could be removed from the demolished car.

Listed as dead were William Alford Getts, 21, Glenwood; Wayne Broadword, 20, and his brother, Ellsworth, 22, Springfield; Leroy Eugene Hicks, 22, Eugene; Mrs. Marjorie Richey, Eugene; Donna Henager, 20, Eugene; Neva Ryel, 19, Cheshire; Kenneth Gillette, 20, Springfield.

The six bus passengers hospitalized were from the Eugene and Portland areas, and a mother and son from Montana. Their injuries were not serious.

Italian Police Admit Hoax

VENICE, Dec. 16 (AP)—Red-faced Venice police have discovered they say, that the "American army captain" who reported that bandits had kidnapped his wife and stolen his jeep actually was a notorious Italian swindler and had robbed them of a jeep.

Yesterday the police announced that a man who identified himself as Capt. John Willis told them that he and his wife were held up while driving along a country road and that the robbers retained the woman hostage and sent him back for ransom money of \$2250.

Police lent him a jeep but withheld the money. He and the police went to the "payoff" spot. There police waited while he went ahead to make contact.

After a short delay, they followed him. Both he and the jeep had vanished.

Circulars were sent to police stations through Italy identifying the man as William Capuzzo of Chiglogia, near Venice, where police said he had represented himself as a captain in the U. S. 88th division.
