

Alaska Ships Limited By Union Row

SEATTLE, Dec. 18 (AP)—Drastic restrictions on cargo bound for Ketchikan, Alaska, were ordered today by the three Seattle shipping companies serving Alaska after word was received from the northern port that the first vessel to arrive there after the prolonged maritime strike was involved in a jurisdictional dispute between rival AFL-CIO unions.

The new order places immediate restriction on Ketchikan cargo loadings to only one hatch on vessels loading in Seattle. Cargo amounts also will be limited pending settlement of the dispute, officials said.

The Ketchikan dispute hinges on who shall man the winches and hatches; the AFL-Sailors union of the Pacific or the CIO-International Longshoremen and Warehousemen's union.

Ed Coester, Sailors' union agent here, said it was an attempt of the ILWU to "move in" on SUP work.

Officials of the CIO union were not available for comment.
