

Aerial Photos Used In Hunt

SEATTLE, Dec. 24 (AP)—New aerial photographs of territory in which a missing marine transport plane may have disappeared two weeks ago were being studied today by navy photo-interpreters for possible clues to the fate of the 32 passengers, Sand Point naval air station said today.

Similar photographs of two western Washington areas showed no good "leads," spokesman said.

Leaders in the rescue effort revealed that between 40 and 50 specific reports had been made of a plane being heard overhead in stormy weather the afternoon of Dec. 10, the date of the plane's disappearance en route from San Diego to Seattle. All but 10 or 12 have been investigated.

Slot Machines Still Illegal

SALEM, Dec. 24 (AP)—Attorney General George Neuner said he had advised the Columbia county district attorney that St. Helens' city council plans to license slot machines conflicts with state laws.

Neuner said the supreme court has ruled the machines are a lottery and in violation of the state constitution.
