

Sanity Test Will Be Given

FRESNO, Calif., Jan. 3 (AP)—A sanity test will be conducted before Edward Wayne Rogers, 19, escapee from an Oregon mental institution, is brought to trial on arson and murder charges.

Superior Judge Ernest Klette suspended proceedings yesterday pending the test, which will be conducted by Dr. Max D. Levi, Fresno, and Dr. R. B. Tolker, director of the Stockton state hospital. No date was set for their report.

Rogers is charged with murder in connection with the death of Nightwatchman Peter Fuchs in the fire at the Fresno Exchange Packing company last September 13, one of the blazes Rogers is accused of setting.

Bank Robbers Still Missing

VANCOUVER, Wash., Jan. 3 (AP)—The whereabouts of the three bandits who robbed the Battle Ground, Wash., State bank of \$18,000 Tuesday remained a mystery today.

The three sped away in a sedan and are believed to have changed to another car two miles from Battle Ground. They have not been seen since. A bullet hole and blood in the abandoned car indicated one of them was struck by a bullet from the gun of a U. S. marshal as they fled.

The FBI took over investigation, and authorities say only a few clues are being followed.
