A flashing right cross to the jaw put an end to last night's armory main boxing event—a third-round knockout for Ursal Snapp over Joe Woods.

The second canto was more of a defensive fight on both sides, but Snapp's reach was coming in mighty handy. Joe Woods was on the floor for a second early in that heat, but his rushing late in the round almost pulled that one out for him.  
A virtual capacity crowd at the armory witnessed the first boxing card of the new year.  
The preliminaries were also good.  
In the welterweight semi-windup Monte Montgomery won a TKO from Ralph Weiser in the third, after he had more or less carried Weiser for two heats. Referee Wally Moss at the end of the second warned both boys to get in and fight, and Montgomery almost made hamburger of Weiser's visage in the next minute of slugfests.  
Bob Eastman knocked out his middleweight opponent, Glenn O'Neill, in the second round of a scheduled four-rounder. The first stanza was even, and both boys went out for murder in the second.

# Pro Football Fix . . . Filchuck Admits He Lied About Bribery

NEW YORK, Jan. 8 (AP)—Mayor William O'Dwyer gave Halfback Frank Filchuck a "clean bill of health" to play in the New York Giants-Chicago Bears title football game December 15, because the passing ace insisted he had not received a bribe offer. Yet, court exhibits indicated that the district attorney's office had evidence eight hours before the kickoff that Filchuck definitely had received an offer of \$2500 to throw the game, but was permitted to play anyway.  
This was brought out in general sessions court yesterday when Assistant District Attorney George Monaghan read into the record the signed statement of "big brother," that he had made the fix bid to both Filchuck and Fullback Merle Hapes at least five days before the game.  
The statement was introduced in evidence in Paris' trial on the six charges shortly before the state rested its case. Monaghan said he personally had taken the statement from the slim 28-year-old novelty manufacturer, and that it was signed and delivered at 6:15 a. m., December 15, the morning of the game. There were still eight hours to go before the 2:05 p. m. kickoff, yet no ban was put on Filchuck.  
Hapes, however, was barred from the tilt. At the time, National Football League Commissioner Bert Bell revealed that the reason he permitted Filchuck to play was because the mayor, himself, after questioning the halfback privately, suggested it.  
"When we were in the mayor's Gracie mansion the night before the game," Bell related, "Mr. O'Dwyer took Filchuck into another room alone. They came out and the mayor put his arm on Filchuck's shoulder and said he had a clean bill of health and suggested that he be allowed to play."  
Filchuck did admit in his testimony yesterday that he lied to the mayor about not having received the bribe bid, because he feared that if he admitted it, he would be benched.  
Both Hapes and Filchuck admitted that Paris had offered them money to throw the game, that they both turned the bid down, but that they continued to see Paris afterward in spite of it. Both said they were interested in getting jobs with Paris' novelty manufacturing concern.  
In his statement, Paris related he made the offer to Hapes at the Copacabana night club the night of December 8, and to Filchuck in the Paris office-apartment on West 56th street on December 10.
