

Two Steel Firms Ask Halt To Portal To Portal Suits

WASHINGTON, Jan. 16 (AP)—Two steel firms appealed to congress today to relieve industry from portal-to-portal pay claims which, one company asserted, threatens to throw the nation "into an economic tangle."

The request came from the American Rolling Mill Co. and the Republic Steel Corp., targets of back pay suits totaling \$76,000,000. The suits were filed as a result of a supreme court decision that workers are entitled to wages for all time they are required to spend on an employer's property.

Charles R. Hook, president of American Rolling Mill, told a senate judiciary subcommittee that his firm, with headquarters at Middletown, O., is being sued for "not less than \$20,000,000" in portal claims. The subcommittee is considering legislation to eliminate employer liability in connection with the back pay suits.

Hook asserted "it is absolutely necessary for congress to enact a law removing this fantastic threat to the solvency of American industry."

CG Men Explain New Policy

Orange Yeast Rolls

1 cup Milk
2 cakes Compressed Yeast
1/2 cup Sugar

Scald milk. Dissolve sugar in milk and cool to lukewarm. Crumble yeast and add to cooled milk. Let stand 5 minutes.

1 cup Fisher's Blend Flour

Add flour and beat until smooth.

1/2 teaspoon Salt
1/2 cup Melted Butter
2 Eggs

Add salt, melted butter and well-beaten eggs, stirring thoroughly.

4 cups Fisher's Blend Flour

Sift and measure flour. Gradually beat into above mixture.

Cover and let stand in a warm place until doubled in bulk. (Dough will hold imprint of finger when pressed.) When light, punch down, place on lightly floured board and pat out one-fourth inch thick. Spread with orange filling and roll as for jelly roll. Pinch edges together to seal dough and to retain juice. Cut dough in one-inch slices. Place in well-greased muffin pans. Let rise until doubled in bulk. Bake at 400° F. 15-20 minutes.

Orange Filling

1/2 cup Sugar
1/2 cup Shortening
4 tablespoons Orange Juice
Grated rind of 3 Oranges

Mix together and cook until thick enough to spread. Cool before spreading.

Morse Slates Seven Oregon Speeches

WASHINGTON, Jan. 16 (AP)—Senator Morse (R-Ore.) announced today he will make seven speeches in Oregon soon.

He said he would speak in Pendleton at noon January 28, at La Grande that night, at Baker at noon January 29 and at Portland the night of January 30. He will speak at Astoria at noon January 30 and at noon and night meetings at Eugene February 1.

Eleanor Loses Driver's Tag

ALBANY, N. Y., Jan. 16 (AP)—New York state has revoked the driving license of Mrs. Eleanor Roosevelt as the result of an accident at Yonkers last August, but the former First Lady may apply for reinstatement after 30 days.

Notice of revocation was received by Mrs. Roosevelt yesterday.

Howard P. Miles, deputy commissioner of motor vehicles, said the penalty was the usual one for such cases. He said Mrs. Roosevelt could apply for reinstatement after 30 days but that she would have to pass a driver's test.

The revocation followed a hearing Jan. 8 at White Plains conducted by William F. Glavin, chief referee of the motor vehicle department.

Five persons, including Mrs. Roosevelt, were injured in the accident involving three automobiles on the Saw Mill river parkway.

Police said Mrs. Roosevelt reported at the time that she had dozed slightly and that her car crossed over into the opposite lane.

In an affidavit submitted at the hearing, however, she contended the sun was in her eyes.

Eastern Herds To Be Checked

SALEM, Jan. 16 (AP)—The increasing practice of bringing feeder cattle from eastern Oregon to western Oregon for fattening is complicating efforts to fight Bang's disease in western Oregon herds, State Agriculture Director E. L. Peters told the house food and livestock committee.

Peters said his department would introduce measures to tighten the Bang's disease laws, with rigid restrictions for places where beef cattle are feeding near dairy cattle.

Peters said doctors are finding more cases of undulant fever, and that it might be necessary to make testing of dairy herds compulsory in eastern Oregon.
