

Chelan Hero, Children, Get Medal

PITTSBURGH, Pa., Jan. 23 (AP)—A Wenatchee school teacher, his son and his daughter have been awarded bronze medals by the Carnegie hero fund commission for their rescue efforts in the fatal plunge of a school bus into Lake Chelan, north central Washington state, during a blizzard November 26, 1945.

Fifteen children and the bus driver were drowned in the accident.

The recipients were Alan R. Rice, rural route 3, Wenatchee; his son, Alan Herbert Rice, 17, and daughter, Margaret Elaine Rice, 15.

The commission's citation accompanying Miss Rice's award declared she saved Mariette L. Archer, 17, from drowning when the bus in which they were riding plunged down a bank and submerged 20 feet from shore in 30 feet of water.

The father's citation credited him with pausing only long enough to remove his shoes before plunging into the water and assisting in the rescue of Miss Archer and in his son's rescue of Mrs. Glenn Brown, another passenger. The father, the citation said, disregarded the fact that he was a poor swimmer.

The father and son were not passengers in the bus.

Civil Service Exams Slated

The state civil service commission has announced examinations for the positions of county welfare administrator and caseworker II, to be held in Klamath Falls late in February, 1947. H. O. Palmer of Klamath Union high school will monitor the examinations. These examinations are being given to fill vacancies in the offices of the state public welfare commission throughout the state. As a result of such examinations eligible lists will be established from which present and future vacancies will be filled.

The beginning salary for county welfare administrator I is \$170 a month and \$215 for county welfare administrator II. The salary for caseworker II is \$165 a month. Applicants must have a college degree in the field of social science and social work experience.

Application blanks may be obtained at any office of the Oregon state employment service or county public welfare office or by writing or calling in person at either the Portland office of the civil service commission at 620 Mead building or 444 Center street, Salem.

State School Budget Okayed

SALEM, Jan. 23 (AP)—The joint ways and means sub-committee on higher education said today it has been advised that the state board of higher education is satisfied with its \$21,355,946 budget for the next two years.

The amount is \$4,400,000 less than the board originally requested, the budget having been pruned by Budget Director George Aiken.

Most of the reduction was accomplished by eliminating \$3,500,000 for capital outlay for the next biennium.

The sub-committee said it would investigate complaints by eastern Oregon legislators that facilities of the animal husbandry department at Oregon State college are insufficient.
