NOTICE TO PROPERTY OWNERS
 WHOSE PROPERTY HAS BEEN FOUND LIABLE FOR THE COST OF IMPROVING DOTY STREET FROM THE SOUTH LINE OF UPHAM STREET TO THE SOUTHWESTERLY LINE OF NO. 7th STREET AND NO. 7th STREET FROM THE SOUTHEASTERLY LINE OF DOTY STREET TO THE SOUTHEASTERLY LINE OF MT. WHITNEY STREET AND KNOWN AS IMPROVEMENT UNIT NO. 92. THAT THEY HAVE TWENTY DAYS FROM THE FIRST PUBLICATION OF THIS NOTICE IN WHICH TO FILE APPLICATION TO PAY THE ASSESSMENTS IN TEN EQUAL INSTALLMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, and by ordinance No. 4099, duly adopted the 8th day of January, 1947, declared the proportionate assessment on each lot, part of lot, block, or parcel of acreage property found to be benefited for a proportionate share of the cost of improving Doty Street from the South line of Upham Street to the Southwest line of No. 7th Street and No. 7th Street from the Southeast line of Doty Street to the Southeast line of Mt. Whitney Street, all as more fully and in detail shown on the plans and specifications of the City Engineer on file with the Police Judge of said City in the matter of said improvement.

That the property so found benefited and assessed as aforesaid, is the property that lies within the boundaries of the following description: Beginning at the northwest corner of Shives addition to the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, on the south line of Upham Street; thence west to the alley in block 2 of First Addition to the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon; thence southwesterly thru alley in blocks 2 and 3 of last said addition to the center of lot 7 in block 3 of said First Addition, thence southeasterly and parallel to No. 7th street thru the center of lot 7 block 3, lots 2 and 8 in block 2 and lot 3 in block 14 said ad-

dillon to the alley in said block 14; thence northeasterly thru the alley in block 14 and 13 of said addition to the center of lot 3 of said block 13; thence northwesterly thru the center of lot 2 of said block 13 and addition and parallel with No. 7th Street to the alley in said block 7; thence northeasterly thru alley in block 7 and 6 of said addition to the west line of said Shives addition; thence north along said addition line to the point of beginning.

- SMALL BUSINESS must be certified by and purchase through RFC.
- STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS must show evidence of authority to purchase.
- NON-PROFIT INSTITUTIONS must be certified. Information available at nearest WAA office.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL SALES (INCLUDING NON-PRIORITY COMMERCIAL GROUPS)

- Payments must be made when requested, unless credit has been established in advance at WAA Regional Office. Business checks, or approved personal checks, will be accepted.
- Purchaser's order must state thereon:
 - "This order is subject to WAA Standard Conditions of Sale, and all other advertised terms and conditions and no other terms or conditions shall be binding on WAA."
 - Type of business and level of trade.
 - Exporters buy at wholesale level.
 - Wholesalers must sign "Wholesaler Certificate."
