Campaign On At Nazarene

Harold W. Gretzinger of Salt Lake City, Utah, son of a world famous London organist and a celebrated musician in his own name, will conduct an evangelistic campaign at the Church of the Nazarene, Martin and Garden, for the week of February 2 to 9, announced the Rev. Howard Lane, pastor, today.

Evangelist Gretzinger has had a wide experience in the field of music, serving for four years as the dean of the music department of Northwest Nazarene college, Nampa, Ida. He is organizing and directing a chorus choir for the special meeting, featuring the choir at each service. He is also a marimba artist and will play the marimba and the cathedral chimes each night.

Rev. Gretzinger has been in the evangelistic field for many years working with such world famous men as Gypsy Smith. He served as assistant pastor of the First Baptist church of Pontiac, Mich., was assistant pastor of First Church of the Nazarene of both Chicago and Detroit, and has just closed a nine-year pastorate of the Church of the Nazarene of Salt Lake City, Utah.

Interested in the relation of Bible data and science, Evangelist Gretzinger has made a unique study of the atomic bomb, interviewing the pilot, Major Swain, of the B-29, which dropped the bomb at Bikini; spending time with various leaders of the atomic projects and will speak Monday night on the subject "What Does the Bible Say About the Atomic Bomb?"
