

Coal Short London Shivers In Face Of North Sea Gale

LONDON, Feb. 6 (AP)—Twenty grimy ships braved a howling North sea gale today, heading down the east coast of Britain with 45,000 tons of coal for storm-bound London, hard hit by a fuel famine that has closed down hundreds of industries throughout the nation. Sixty-seven other coal ships still were tied up in South Wales and northeast coast ports by wild seas. A new storm and cold wave blanketed all of the British Isles and most of western Europe with several inches of snow.

Berlin, chilled by the third cold wave of the worst winter in six years, reported two more

persons frozen to death last night, bringing the known toll from cold and exposure to at least 105 since December 1. More Berlin industries closed because of the low temperatures and lack of coal. A fuel shortage also caused widespread unemployment in the Russian occupation zone and led the Brandenburg provincial government to order emergency unemployment compensation benefits.

In western Germany snow piled high, road traffic was blocked in country districts, and industry—cut back 25 to 50 per cent with the onset of the severe
