# Timber Land Thinned Out

Forest service crews recently completed an important work on 170 acres of timber land near Lakeview. This pruning and thinning of the forest stand was the beginning of a long-term plan of the Fremont forest for increasing the quality and quantity of timber growth. It is a part of the forest service program for more intensively managing the forest.

The two projects recently completed included 120 acres on Drews creek below Drews dam and 50 acres at Snyder meadow in the McDonald area. It is hoped that work can be renewed later this spring in the Snyder meadow area. Forest officials estimate that 300,000 acres of timber land on the Fremont needs this type of work. However, funds are available for only a small percentage of this total.

# Crippled Boy Shoots Father

NEW YORK, Feb. 13 (AP)—An 18-year-old crippled youth who police said shot and critically wounded his father after warning him not to "talk that way to mom" was held today on a charge of felonious assault.

Shot in the chest by a bullet from his own service revolver, Patrolman Robert J. Smith, 41, the father, was in a critical condition in a Brooklyn hospital.

Assistant District Attorney Victor Levin of Queens said the youth, Joseph Smith, told him he could no longer stand bickering between his parents.

# Church Service Said Too Noisy

PASADENA, Calif., Feb. 13 (AP)—The constitution guarantees Americans freedom of worship, but police think it also implies the right to sleep.

Residents in the neighborhood of the Church of Christ complained that services are so noisy that it is impossible to sleep. Sgt. G. S. Wilson and J. D. Nichols stationed themselves half a block away, and agreed.

They had a talk with the Rev. Thomas Griffith, who promised that services will be quieter.

# Jap Officers Get Death Sentence

HONGKONG, Feb. 13 (AP)—A British war crimes court today sentenced Japanese Col. Tokunaga Isao and Capt. Saito Shumkochi to be hanged for failing to provide anti-diphtheria serum at prison camps, thereby causing the death of 200 men, including 54 Canadian soldiers.

Three other defendants were given prison sentences.

# "Fantasy In Fashion" Is Shown To Sojourners

One crepe street dress showed a cape-draped collar, pulled up to use as a scarf.

# U. S., Canada To Cooperate

WASHINGTON, Feb. 13 (AP)—The United States and Canada were disclosed today to have agreed on a full exchange of military intelligence—information on what other nations are up to.

The provision is one of a series of point-by-point agreements underlying a general accord to extend indefinitely the wartime collaboration of American and Canadian armed forces, persons familiar with the year-long negotiations said.

The formal statement made no reference to this background. But the disclosure of a compact for interchange of military intelligence has deep significance for at least two reasons:

1. Canada's geographical position along the Polar Cap air route over which an attack from Europe or Northern Asia might come.
2. Canada herself is a recent victim of an atom bomb espionage plot involving Soviet Russia.

# Mexican Big Horn Sheep Increase

ALBUQUERQUE, N. M., Feb. 13 (AP)—Mexican big horn sheep are thriving on the San Andres refuge near Las Cruces in southern New Mexico.

Cecil A. Kennedy, San Andres manager, says the herd has increased from 35 to 85 since 1941 when the refuge was established for the animals which were fast approaching extinction.

Kennedy told western refuge managers of the fish and wild life service in annual session that gains probably were due to constant patrol and control of mountain lions and other predators.
