

US, Canada To Establish Weather Stations On Rim Of Far Northern America

WASHINGTON, March 5 (AP)—The uninhabited rim of the North American continent, a vast blind spot for weathermen and military strategists, soon will be manned by watchers of the United States and Canada.

The project, officially disclosed in Ottawa and Washington involves the joint establishment of nine new weather stations in Canadian territory.

It is part of the recently announced plan to continue the wartime collaboration of the two nations by exchanging information, personnel and facilities for "peacetime joint security purposes."

At least two of the new stations will be in the far north, one on Ellesmere Island, 600 miles from the north pole, another to the westward on Melville Island.

These, with the other outposts in the chain to the southward, will fill in a blank area between weather stations maintained by the United States in Alaska and one at Thule, in Greenland.

The Ellesmere and Melville island stations are expected to be completed and manned this summer.

Officials of the two governments confirmed their public announcement yesterday to the advantages of improving the weather reporting system. But strategists noted the preeminent military value of constantly manned installations thatward the air routes over the Polar cap.

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States used weather reports from Russia, particularly those on storm movements from Siberia which eventually reached such areas as the Aleutians and Alaska from which American air and naval forces were operating against the Japanese.

Italian Cabinet Banishes Kings

ROME, March 5 (AP)—A government decree published today provided that if former King Vittorio Emanuele and Umberto ever returned to Italy they

would be turned over to the police and, as "foreigners, expelled from the territory of the state."

The edict, voted recently by the cabinet, also forbade male descendants of the two to return. It prohibited the former kings from disposing of their property

in Italy pending a government decision.

Vittorio Emanuele, who abdicated in May, 1946, is in Egypt. Umberto, called in the placards of June, 1946, is in Portugal.

Britain To Cut Royal Navy

LONDON, March 5 (AP)—Britain will reduce the royal navy 60 per cent this year.

The admiralty announced today, in its budget estimates for

1947-48, that the total number of naval officers, seamen, boys and royal marines would be reduced from the 1946-47 maximum of 487,800 to 192,000 during the twelve months beginning April 1.

As a result of the manpower slash Britain's annual bill for the navy will be reduced from \$785,800,000 to \$274,400,000.

13 Juveniles Committed As Delinquents Here

Thirteen juveniles—seven boys and six girls—were committed to institutions as delinquent children by the Klamath county court during 1946, according to an annual statistical report prepared by Mrs. Faye Blackmer, juvenile officer.

A total of 464 youngsters were involved in delinquency cases in Klamath county during the year and 143 were held in detention by juvenile authorities for a day or more.

An age breakdown shows that of 89 children's cases handled and officially disposed of during the year, more 16-year-olds were in trouble than any other juvenile age. That number was 23, 18 of them boys. Seventeen youngsters aged 17, and 11 aged 15 came into the score of the juvenile office on officially disposed of cases.

The department also handled 518 unofficial cases which were settled without court action, and the year's work involved 560 different children.

Strange Coalition Formed In Islands

MANILA, March 5 (AP)—A strange coalition of former guerrilla forces and collaborators under the Japanese has been formed in the Philippines in opposition to the proposal to grant Americans equal rights with Filipinos in developing and exploiting the natural resources of the islands.

The coalition between the former antagonists has been brought to light in the final campaigning before the national plebiscite which will decide the question March 11.
