

Sheriff Testifies At Trial

VALE, Ore., March 5 (AP)—In a state attempt to prove that Mrs. Gladys Broadhurst conspired with a young paramour to slay her wealthy husband, Sheriff Charles Glenn took the stand again today.

The sheriff testified that 23-year-old Alvin Lee Williams, who is accused of doing the actual shooting of W. D. Broadhurst, told him about a "twin brother" of Mrs. Broadhurst's fifth husband, Leslie Lincoln.

The prosecution contends that Mrs. Broadhurst invented the twin as a scapegoat which would divert suspicion from Williams. The sheriff's testimony was part of the state's attempt to establish a conspiracy between Williams and Broadhurst and enable Williams to be called as a witness.

Glenn also testified that he twice met Leslie Lincoln and noticed a birth mark over his left ear. The 40-year-old red-headed defendant is accused by the state of attributing this birth mark to Lincoln's "twin brother."

Another state witness, 17-year-old Winthrop Godfrey, Caldwell, Idaho, testified that a week before the slaying he sold Williams a car similar to the one the state contends was used to carry Broadhurst's body.

Circuit Judge M. A. Biggs has ruled that Williams may not testify until the state has clearly established a basis for complicity between him and Mrs. Broadhurst. Both are charged with first degree murder.

ICC OK's Carson Nomination

WASHINGTON, March 6 (AP)—The senate interstate commerce committee by a 13 to 0 vote Wednesday approved the nomination of Joseph K. Carson Jr., former mayor of Portland, Ore., as a member of the federal maritime commission.

Carson was opposed at public hearings by the national maritime committee of the congress of industrial organizations but had the endorsement of some Oregon labor leaders.

The nomination now goes to the senate with action possible on Friday.

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6-Man Crew Pushes Work On Telephone Building

Work of enlarging the Pacific Telephone and Telegraph building in Klamath Falls is progressing rapidly to the sound of saws and buzz of jackhammers.

A crew of six men is using the heavy, bouncing jackhammers to bite into the hard cement retaining wall which was built below

street level on the south alley side of the building. Eighteen feet of additional space will be gained by extending the basement on this side and building up from it to two-story level.

Foreman of the construction job is Earl Godding, 2041 Ogden. A temporary structure 18 by 80 feet on the west or Pine street side of the building has been erected as an office and workshop and here the six carpenters are busy sawing and hammering on the \$150,000 job.

The long shed-like structure is equipped with door and glassed windows and extends across the sidewalk of the street. It will probably be there until late summer, Godding said.

Leo N. Huls, contractor, estimates that the construction will be completed some time this fall.

Welles Speaks At Brotherhood Week

TACOMA, March 6 (AP)—The atomic bomb has made the brotherhood of man a necessity, Orson Welles, stage, screen and radio star, said here last night.

The alternative to the golden rule, he declared is "destruction."

"You love your fellow man or else," he told an audience in the armory, gathered in celebration of brotherhood week.

"There are laws against dope-peddling," he declared. "There can be laws against race hatred. That statement is not communism."

No World Surplus Of Grain Seen

WASHINGTON, March 6 (AP)—D. A. Fitzgerald, secretary general of the international emergency food council, said Wednesday that "no real world surplus" of broad grains is in sight before the 1948 harvest.

Fitzgerald, who accompanied former President Hoover on the latter's recent survey of the food situation in Europe, told a news conference that winter crop damage in Europe has been severe. He added:

"Even if production is large in North America, as now seems possible judging from the U. S. winter wheat crop forecast, the crop here is not likely to fill the gap in world supplies resulting from lower output in western Europe."

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Chinese Discounts Formosa Riots

NANKING, March 6 (AP)—Minister of Information Peng Hsueh-pei discounted today the seriousness of reports of rioting in Formosa, which an observer yesterday said bordered on a revolution.

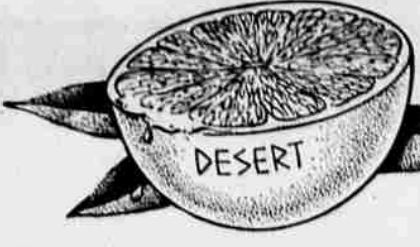
Peng said the efforts of small dealers in Formosa to roll their own cigarettes in violation of the government tobacco monopoly

was the basic cause of the rioting. Reports from Formosa now indicate that the situation is under control, the information chief said.

CHOCOLATE NUGGET LOAF

Martha Meade

A delicious loaf with that's sugar saving too! Perfect for lunch box, afternoon tea, or dinner dessert with fruit.

- Sift flour before measuring. Use level measurements for all ingredients.
- Have all ingredients at room temperature (about 70°).
- Preheat oven to baking temperature, 350°, a slow-moderate oven.
- Grease and flour an oblong baking dish, 10x6x2 inches.
- Sift together into a mixing bowl—
- 1 1/2 cups sifted Sperry Drifted Snow "Home-Perfected" Enriched Flour
 - 2 1/4 teaspoons double-action baking powder
 - 3/4 teaspoon salt
 - 1 cup granulated sugar
- Add—
- 1/2 cup high grade vegetable shortening (part butter for flavor)

- 1/2 cup semi-sweet chocolate bits (or coarsely chopped semi-sweet chocolate)
 - 1/4 cup chopped walnuts
- Bake in preheated oven for 40-45 minutes. Remove from oven and let loaf stand in baking dish a moment before turning onto wire rack to cool, 9-12 servings.
