

\$46 Thousand Tax On FDR's Estate

POUGHKEEPSIE, N. Y., Mar. 7 (AP) — An order filed with Dutchess county surrogate Frederick Quintiero today fixed a

New York state tax of \$45,992.99 on a net estate of \$1,065,614.11 of the late President Roosevelt. The order was filed by William E. Duggan, tax appraiser in Dutchess county for the New York state department of tax-

ation and finance, who explained the net estate of the late president was fixed for state purposes only.

Last September attorneys for the president's estate filed \$50,000 with the department in Albany to cover whatever tax was assessed.
