

# Angell Outlines GOP Hopes To Slash All Unnecessary Governmental Spending

WASHINGTON, March 7 (AP) Rep. Angell (R-Ore.) said today that a cut of \$8,000,000,000 in the budget won't mean that appropriations for the armed services will be trimmed enough to cause them injury.

The proposed budget cuts, he said, were not " earmarked for any particular agency."

"The congress itself when taking final action," he said in a statement, "may, if it chooses, make the full appropriation recommended by the president for the armed services."

Angell said it was likely that a compromise between the house cut of \$8,000,000,000 and the senate's \$4,500,000,000 slice in the president's \$37,500,000,000 budget would be worked out.

Continuing, Angell said:

"There is a determined effort on the part of the republican organization to cut out all waste and extravagance in federal expenditures wherever they may be and top officials in the armed services themselves admit that there is plenty of opportunity to eliminate waste and needless spending in these services without interfering with the efficiency of the national defense."

"That is what is uppermost in the minds of republican leaders who are determined to eliminate as far as humanly possible the immense waste of federal money by frivolous and unnecessary spending."

## Movie Trial Starts Today

LOS ANGELES, March 7 (AP) Names of the Dolly sisters, George Jessel, George M. Cohan; recollections of Florenz Ziegfeld, hit tunes of a generation ago and top vaudeville billing at the Palace gave an air of theatrical nostalgia to a federal courtroom today.

The occasion was the trial which began yesterday before Federal Judge Campbell E. Beaumont of Song Writer Jean Schwartz's suit for \$100,000 damages from 20th Century-Fox studios, Jessel and Roszika Dolly on the ground he was slighted in the movie of the life of Roszika and the late Jenny Dolly. Jessel was the firm's producer.

Schwartz, former husband of Roszika, alleged that he and his lifelong friend, Harry Fox, old-time vaudevillian and former husband of Jenny Dolly, were combined in one character in the movie, depicting Fox as the author of songs and lyrics actually written by Schwartz and that he, Schwartz, was ignored in the script.

Jessel took the stand just before court adjourned until today, long enough to hear a lawyer's question of "do you know the husbands of the Dolly sisters and answer, "some of them."

## Willamette Bridge Proposal Made

PORTLAND, March 7 (AP)—A hearing on the state highway commission proposal to build a bridge across the Willamette river at Independence will be held in Salem April 1.

Col. Orville E. Walsh, district army engineer, set the date. The commission asks a permit for a bridge with a 68-foot vertical clearance and a 142-foot horizontal clearance.

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## Students Hear Roosevelt Talk

PORTLAND, March 7 (AP) — Plain business sense should lead the United States to help other nations now, Mrs. Eleanor Roosevelt told the Pacific Northwest College conference yesterday.

Delegates from 34 schools of the Pacific northwest and Alaska heard her predict that the domestic needs of this country will not require the nation's full production 10 years from now.

"This means we must take an interest in the way people live all over the world, not just because we are humanitarians, but because we are realistic and must rehabilitate the economies of our potential markets," she said.

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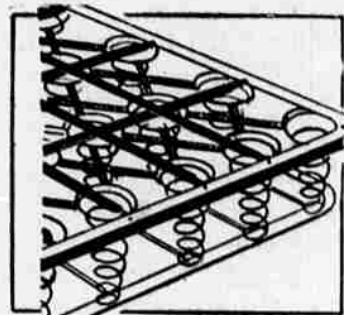
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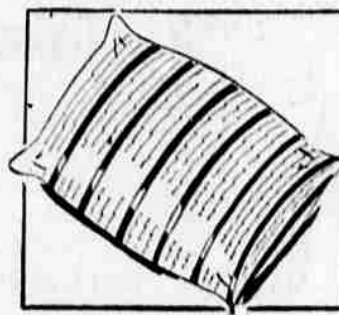
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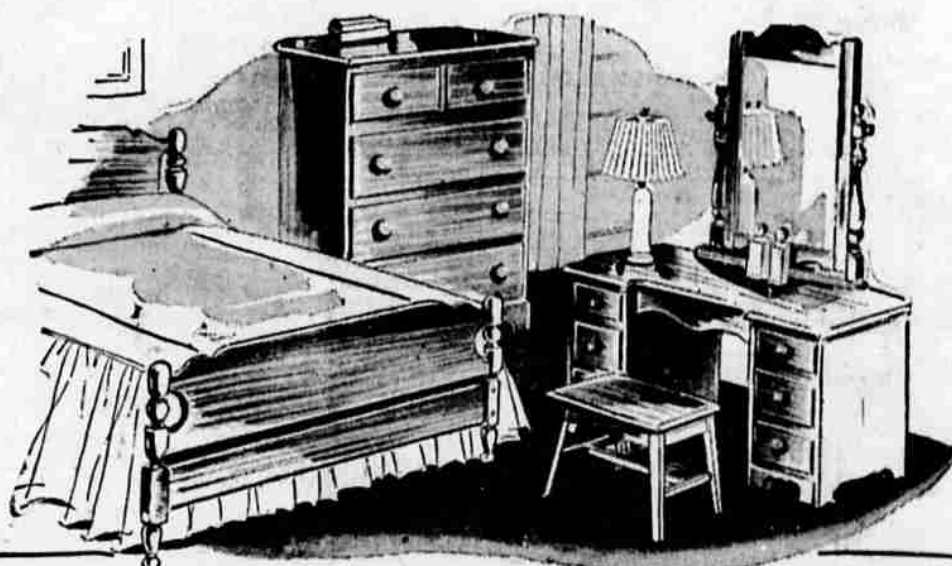
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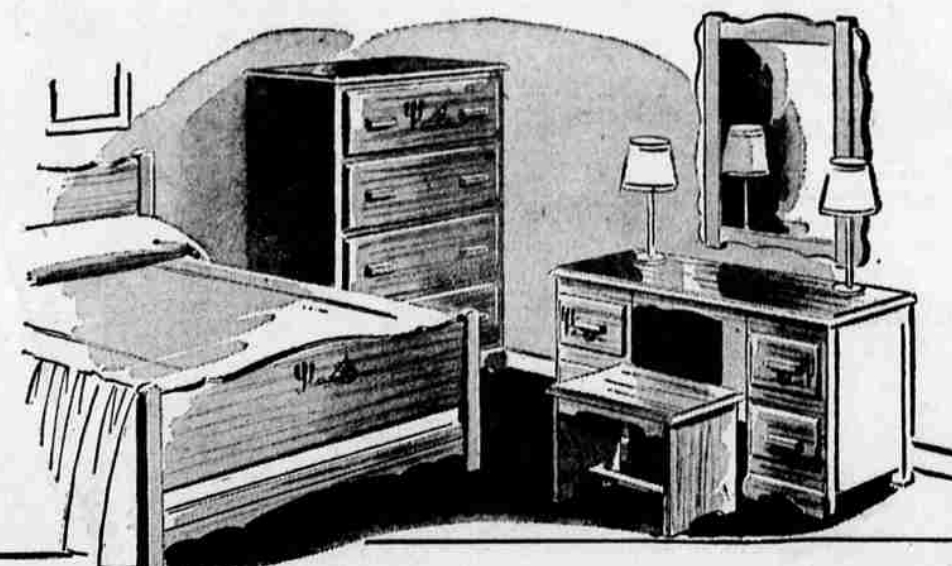


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
