N. Two men will be elected from the northwest group to go to Lake Success as representatives of the organization.

Among committees set up at the meeting were world business, atomic energy, legalities, economics and disarmament. The group was addressed by Mrs. Eleanor Roosevelt, Laughton Tatum, national vice president of the Junior chamber of commerce; Robert Farrell, Oregon secretary of state, and Dr. Robert Odegaard, president of Reed college.

Young stated that he considered the meeting a great success and thought that it was an important step in world peace.

MEDFORD, March 10 (AP)—Forest Wilson, 30, has been indicted by the Jackson county grand jury on a charge of first degree murder in the shotgun death of John B. Camden in an attempted card game robbery last November 10.

Certified potato seed planted at Oceanside test plots, disease and marketing problems, will be the major subjects of discussion in a meeting of Klamath potato growers at the Merrill high school, Tuesday, March 11 at 7:30 p. m., according to the county agent's office.

Dr. J. A. Milbrath, associate plant pathologist, will discuss Oceanside test plot results and leaf roll in particular. Walter Jendrzewski, assistant county agent, who has attended the Oceanside field day in company with Scott Warren, president of the Klamath Potato Growers association and other officials of the Klamath Potato Growers association, will also report on Klamath seed potatoes.

Bryant Williams of the Klamath Potato Growers association and Eldon Larsen of the Tulelake Growers will report on their recent market survey of Klamath potatoes in major California markets. Scott Warren will outline tentative methods for improving present marketing procedure of Klamath potatoes.

### Mrs. Carrie Catt Dies At Age Of 88

NEW ROCHELLE, N. Y., Mar. 10 (AP)—Mrs. Carrie Chapman Catt, 88, who entered the fight for world peace after her unflagging crusade for women's suffrage had succeeded, died yesterday of heart disease at her home here.

Only two days before she had told her biographer, Mary Gray Peck, that she hoped to live to see the United Nations become a "going concern."

"With the passing of Mrs. Carrie Chapman Catt, an era in our national life comes to a close," President Truman said in a telegram delivered yesterday to the Catt home. "She will be widely mourned and long remembered."
