

Senate To Talk Rent Control

WASHINGTON, March 20 (AP)—A senate banking subcommittee will try to get together tomorrow on a bill to fix the future of rent controls, with members in a mood to finish the job "in short order."

Senator Cain (R-Wash.), who passed this word along to reporters, said two main points of contention remain:

1. Whether the bill should hand over controls to a federal agency or leave enforcement to the courts.

2. Whether there should be a general increase in rent ceilings or provision for boosts in individual cases.

Cain is a member of the group which is considering a measure to extend the controls beyond their June 30 expiration date.

The subcommittee wrote one bill providing for a 10 per cent hike in ceilings. The full banking committee rejected it, indicating that it was not disposed to approve any across-the-board increase.

Cain said there seemed to be general agreement to take controls of new housing in the belief it would encourage construction.

"Why not do it right now?" he asked. "All I want is action."

VA Designates Business Fund

The veterans' administration has set aside \$10,245 a month to reimburse the Oregon state division of vocational education for expenses of inspecting and supervising some 3500 business firms participating in the on-the-job training program. Zeno H. Dent, VA training officer in this area, said today.

This is expected to increase to \$13,000 a month under a new agreement to add apprenticeable trades to the state's supervisory program which now is devoted largely to the non-apprenticeable field, Dent reported. VA funds are used only for salaries and expenses of state field inspectors; in January these numbered 40 on full or part time.

Three Pacific northwest states—Oregon, Washington and Montana—are now eligible to receive about \$25,000 monthly from the VA to help pay for inspection of job training firms under the GI bill. Idaho is not participating as it has no state law allowing acceptance of federal funds for such a purpose.

Tongue Point Payroll Totalled

ASTORIA, March 20 (AP)—The payroll of the Tongue Point naval station, exclusive of workers on the nearby naval housing project, amounts to \$225,000 a month, or \$2,700,000 a year, Capt. S. P. Jenkins, commandant of the 19th fleet, pointed out here today.

Captain Jenkins said this amount includes pay of officers, enlisted men and civilian workers regularly assigned to the station and reserve fleet.

He said this figure is conservative, since most of the officers receive their pay checks from Washington and their sums are not included in the station total.

Hannegan Quashes Quit Rumors

BOSTON, March 20 (AP)—Postmaster General Robert E. Hannegan today spiked reports that he intended to resign either from the cabinet or as democratic national committee chairman.

"I have no plans to resign from anything," he told newsmen as he left Massachusetts Memorial hospital where he underwent an operation to relieve high blood pressure.

British Policeman Killed By Blast

JERUSALEM, March 20 (AP)—A British policeman was killed and five other Britons were injured last night by a bomb explosion on the highway between Haifa and Tel Aviv.

An official announcement said the men were returning to their quarters near Hadera after visiting a motion picture theatre when the blast occurred.

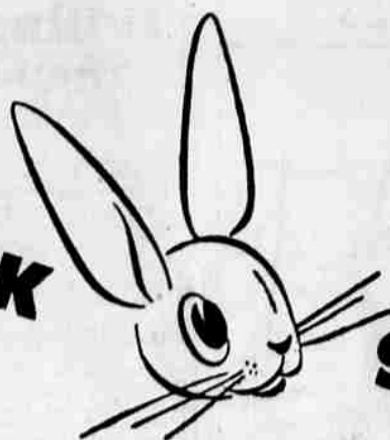
