Klamath Indian Says Time For Freedom Not Here

WASHINGTON, March 27 (AP)—B. J. Jackson, who described himself as a full-blooded Indian from the Klamath Indian reservation in Oregon, said today he does not believe "this is the time for the Indians to be turned loose."

He testified before a senate public lands subcommittee which is considering legislation designed to eventually put Indians on the same basis as white persons.

"Many Indians today do not know what self-help is," Jackson said.

"Many Indians feel they do not have to work. They have grown dependent upon the government."

"The job is to educate them out of that notion. I don't know how long that will take, but it would be wrong to turn the Indians loose until that is done."

President John Houston referred to the civic affairs committee the question of continuing the Community Chest here the coming year. Chairman Arnold Gralapp of the chest board pointed out that the chest program has not been a complete success financially, and asked if it is advisable to continue it. There was considerable expression among those present in favor of going ahead with the combined drive idea here.
