**NOTICE OF BOND SALE**

Sealed proposals will be received by the Common Council of the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, for the purchase of street improvement bonds, Series 78, aggregating Eight Thousand, Four Hundred, Twenty-two and 00/100 Dollars (\$8,422.00), duly authorized by ordinance of the said City of Klamath Falls, for the construction and improvement of the following improvement unit situated in Klamath Falls, Oregon, as follows:

Improvement unit No. 92, extending along Doty Street from the South Line of 10th Street to the Southeastery Line of No. 7th Street and No. 7th Street from the Southeastery line of Doty Street to the Southeastery line of Mt. Whitney Street.

Proposals to purchase said bonds will be received by the undersigned up to and including the 14th day of April, 1947, at the hour of seven-thirty o'clock p. m., of said day and opened at a regular meeting of the Common Council immediately thereafter; said bonds shall be dated the 15th day of April, 1947, and shall be in amounts of \$500.00 each, except bond No. 1, of the series, which shall be for the fractional part of said sum, and all shall be due ten years after the date of issue, payment of the entire bonds optional with said City at any coupon paying date on and after one year from the date thereof. Said bonds will bear interest at the rate of not to exceed six per cent per annum, payable semi-annually on April 15th and October 15th, of each year, principal and interest payable at the office of the treasurer of the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon.
