A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KLAMATH FALLS, OREGON, TO PAVE AND IMPROVE SOUTH SEVENTH STREET FROM THE SOUTH EASTERLY LINE OF OAK AVENUE TO THE NORTHWESTERLY LINE OF

WILLOW AVENUE AND PLUM AVENUE FROM THE NORTHEASTERLY LINE OF SOUTH SEVENTH STREET TO THE NORTHEASTERLY LINE OF NO. 7TH STREET AND DECLARING THE TAKEN IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, SAID PROJECT TO BE KNOWN AS IMPROVEMENT UNIT NO. 82.

WHEREAS, the City Engineer, pursuant to a resolution of the Common Council heretofore adopted, having on the 27th day of March, 1947, filed plans, specifications and estimates for the cost of improving, South 7th Street from the southeasterly line of Oak Avenue to the northeasterly line of Willow Avenue, and Plum Avenue from the northeasterly line of South 7th Street to the northeasterly line of No. 7th Street, said improvement to be known as IMPROVEMENT UNIT NO. 82; and

the plans, specifications and estimates of said project for each type of pavement being as follows:

Type "A"—Cement concrete pavement
Type "B"—Asphalt concrete pavement
Said estimates include engineering, supervision, advertising, clerical assistance, attorney's fees and unforeseen contingencies.

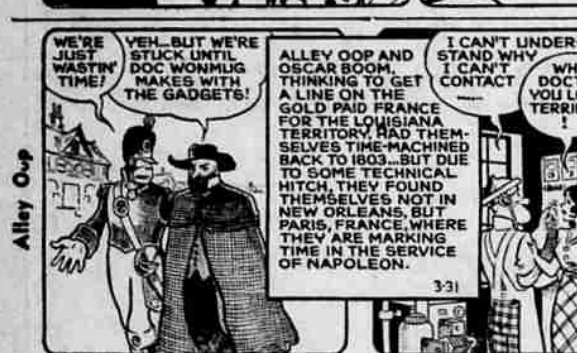
