

U. S. GETS PACIFIC ISLANDS

LAKE SUCCESS, N. Y., April 3 (AP)—The vast chains of Pacific islands, where Japan mounted her attack against the United States, officially went under American control today through security council approval of a United Nations strategic area trusteeship.

Four hours after the unanimous council decision last night, American Delegate Warren R. Austin boarded a train for Washington with the major victory in his pocket.

Austin won the significant triumph in a bitter round of closing debate, where Soviet Delegate Andrei A. Gromyko at one point abstained on a contested section rather than exercise the veto.

Commenting that "this demonstrates that the United Nations does work," Austin took the report to Capitol Hill, where he was called before a house committee to testify on expenditures of the American U. N. delegation.

Austin likewise advised his old colleagues in the senate, which must finally ratify the agreement. Ratification was expected to be a routine step.

The agreement gives the United States sweeping rights, amounting to virtual annexation, under which the government may fortify the vital islands, close them at will for security reasons, and ban foreign aircraft.

As sole administering authority, the United States also received the right to reject any modification or alteration of the terms. This was the point where

Nazi Butcher To Hang

WARSAW, April 3 (AP)—Rudolf Hoess must pay with his own life for more than 4,000,000 lives snuffed out at Oswiecim (Auschwitz) extermination camp in the two and a half years he was nazi commandant there.

The 47-year-old ex-colonel, on trial for three weeks, was sentenced to death last night by the nine-judge Polish supreme national tribunal. The condemned man, stocky and clean shaven and wearing a green German officer's uniform, was calm and attentive as he listened through headphones to the hour-long reading of the judgment. The courtroom was crowded.

Hoess is permitted to ask President Boleslaw Bierut for clemency, but even should he do so this seemed certain to be denied. No date was set for the execution.

Canada Clamps Down On Atom

OTTAWA, April 3 (AP)—Information about atomic energy has been placed under peacetime censorship in Canada by new government regulations replacing wartime controls.

No information about atomic energy may be disclosed without government approval under the new regulations, which were announced last night by C. D. Howe, minister of reconstruction and supply.

Other portions of the new order give the Canadian atomic energy control board peacetime control over almost every phase of atomic research and purchase and ownership of atomic materials, such as uranium and thorium.

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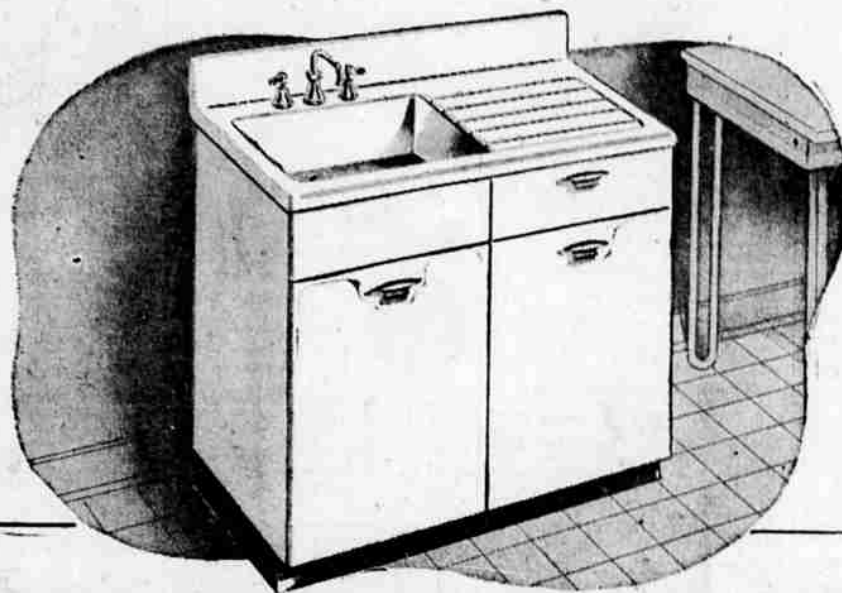
