RESOLUTION No. 172

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL TO PAVE AND IMPROVE SOUTH 7TH STREET FROM THE SOUTHWESTERLY LINE OF OAK AVENUE TO THE NORTHEASTERLY LINE OF WILLIAM AVENUE, AND PLUM AVENUE FROM THE NORTHEASTERLY LINE OF SOUTH 7TH STREET TO THE NORTHEASTERLY LINE OF SOUTH 8TH STREET.

WHEREAS, the City Engineer, pursuant to a resolution of the Common Council heretofore adopted, having on the 27th day of March, 1947, filed plans, specifications and estimates for the cost of improving South 7th Street from the southwestern line of Oak Avenue to the northeastern line of William Avenue and Plum Avenue from the northeastern line of South 7th Street to the northeastern line of South 8th Street to the northeastern line of South 9th Street, said improvement to be known as IMPROVEMENT UNIT No. 92; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, hereby declares its intention to improve said portions of said streets in accordance with the plans, specifications and estimates as follows:

TYPE "A"—To consist of paving streets with seven inches in depth with asphalt concrete, including all work and materials for the complete improvement of said project for each type of pavement being as follows:

Type "A" Cement concrete pavement—\$28,550.01

Type "B" Asphalt concrete pavement—\$23,868.31

Said estimates include engineering supervision, advertising, clerical assistance, attorney's fees and unforeseen contingencies.

Section II

That the property lying within the boundaries heretofore described be and the same is hereby declared to be benefited by the said improvement, to-wit: Beginning at the corner of lot 10 block 96 Klamath Addition to the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon; thence southeasterly along the northwesterly line of Willow Avenue 120 feet to the center of lot 8 of said block 96; thence northwesterly along the center line of said lot 8 to the center of the alley in block 96; thence southeasterly along the alley to the northwesterly line of South 8th Street; thence northwesterly along the center line of said block 94 to the center of lot 3 of said block 94; thence northwesterly along the center line of said lot 3 to the northwesterly line of Oak Avenue; thence northwesterly along Oak Avenue to the center of block 95 of said addition; thence southeasterly along the center of lot 3 of said block 95 and across lot 8 of said block 95 and across the lot line between lots 5 and 6 and 15 and 16 in block 3; thence southeasterly to the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon; thence southeasterly along the northwesterly line of Willow Avenue to the point of beginning.

That all the property included in the aforesaid boundaries above described be and the same is hereby declared to be benefited by the said improvement, and assessed for the expenses thereof.

Section III

That Monday the 21st day of April, 1947, at the hour of 7:30 p. m. at the Council Chamber of the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, be fixed as the time and place for hearing of objections and remonstrances against said proposed improvement.

Section IV

That the Police Judge be and he is hereby authorized and directed to cause notice of such hearing to be published as provided by the City Charter of said City and shall publish this resolution as provided by law.
