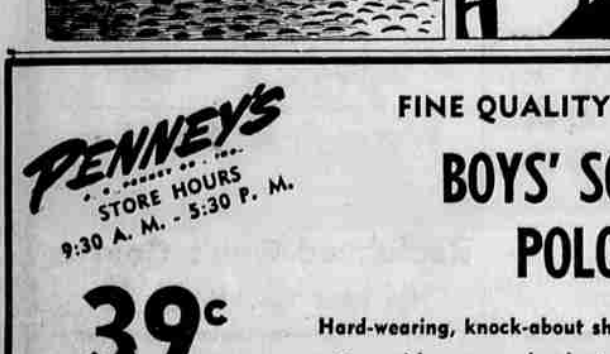
Wonderland association officials have tabulated these major events and announced them as follows:
