

Fisher Tells Of First Fire

Don C. Fisher, custodian of Lava Beds national monument, in Klamath Falls Thursday, reported the first fire of the season occurred Wednesday. The crew answered a call to a blaze on the Shasta national forest where about 40 acres of wooded land in a logging area adjacent to the Lava Beds was threatened before the fire was brought under control.

Railroad Grant Timber Sales Up

PORTLAND, April 18 (AP)—Sale of timber on Oregon and California railroad grant land this year has nearly doubled the figures for the first quarter of 1946, W. H. Horning said today.

Horning, regional administrator of the bureau of land management, said sales in the first three months of this year totaled \$900,902.40, for an average price of \$1.39 a thousand feet.

Last year the figures were \$268,380 for an average price of \$4.28 a thousand feet. The footage: 121,960,000 board feet this year, compared with 62,720,000 in 1946.
