WASHINGTON, April 18 (AP)—Rep. Fred Norman, Washington state republican, died today. His Capitol office said he was 67. Norman's secretary, Riley Zumwalt, said the representative became ill about 7:30 a. m. at the residence of friends with whom he lives. He said they summoned a physician, but that Norman died within a few minutes, apparently of a heart attack.

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Oxbow Power Plant Work Stopped

BAKER, Ore., April 18 (AP)—Work on a proposed \$20,000,000 hydro-electric plant on the Snake river at Oxbow has halted because the Idaho Power company fears a change in power laws, Eastern Oregon legislators said today.

A possible referendum on a power bill passed by the last session of the Oregon legislature prompted the halt, said Senators Austin Dunn and J. N. Jones and Reps. R. C. Frisbie and Martin Gallagher.

The legislators added that they hoped the referendum would not be called. They had advocated passage of the bill to encourage the company to build a 125,000-kilowatt plant on the Baker county site.

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Crop Insurance Experiment Slated

CORVALLIS, April 18 (AP)—Baker county is the guinea pig in a new crop insurance plan, Muri E. Cummings, state director for the federal crop insurance corporation, said today.

The county has been divided into nine insurance areas on the basis of soil types, topography, farming practices and climatic conditions, Cummings said. The amount of coverage on wheat in each area is uniform and varies from seven bushels in the high-risk area to 22.5 in the least-risk area.

If the plan is successful it may replace insurance coverage based on individual farm yields now in effect in 19 other Oregon counties, Cummings said.

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
