In a 10-minute broadcast to an audience vaster than any ever before reached by an heir to the British throne, she spoke particularly to the youth of the far-flung empire.

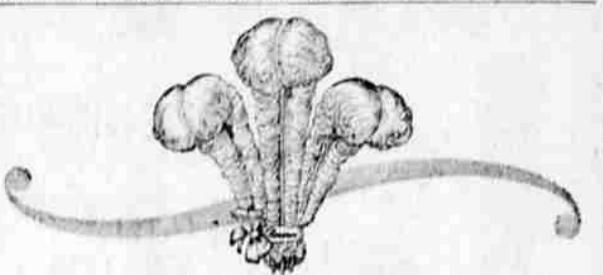
"I declare before you all," she said, "that my whole life, whether it be long or short, shall be devoted to your service and the service of our

Agreement On Atom Energy Doubtful

PORTLAND, April 22 (AP)—Pessimism over possibility of international accord for control of atomic energy was expressed today by a scientist here for educational lectures on nuclear science.

Dr. Leo Szilard, University of Chicago professor, said "I think chances are about one in 10 for a really good solution" of international control. He blamed delays in setting up the atomic energy commission for loss of a year in atomic research by the United States.

The Chicago scientist is here with Dr. Linus Pauling, California Institute of Technology, and Dr. Harrison Brown, University of Chicago. They will speak tonight in behalf of a public education program of the emergency committee of atomic scientists.
