

Power Merger Given Okay

PHILADELPHIA, April 25 (AP)—Merger of Northwestern Electric company into Pacific Power & Light company was approved yesterday by the securities and exchange commission.

Northwestern has provided electric service in Portland, Ore., and Vancouver, Wash. Pacific supplies power to communities in northern Oregon and southern Washington. Both are subsidiaries of American Power & Light company.

The merger previously was approved by public utilities commissions in Oregon and Washington, the city of Portland and the federal power commission.

American plans a capital contribution of \$2,200,000 to Pacific before the merger. Holders of outstanding preferred shares of Northwestern and Pacific will receive:

- 1. One share of \$100 par new Pacific preferred for each share of six per cent preferred of Northwestern and \$6 preferred of Pacific.
- 2. One share of new preferred plus \$5 cash and dividend adjustments for each share of seven per cent preferred of both companies.

Air Hearing Continues

PORTLAND, Ore., April 25 (AP)—The hearing on a proposed air route between the Pacific Northwest and Hawaii went into its fifth day today with airline officials contending there was a rosy future for the route.

A civil aeronautics board official noted that an earlier application was turned down because only eight per cent of the trade with Hawaii originated in the Northwest. Mason line officials asserted that was enough to make commercial operation feasible. They added that establishment of regular flights would stimulate further business. Mason and other contestants for the route—Pan-American, Northwest and Transocean Airlines—also attacked each other's cost figures.
