Something about rummage sales seems to have a peculiar fascination for people—especially people in Klamath Falls—enough at least to make the 30-odd sales held yearly in one location notably successful. "Rummage," according to Webster, as a noun means "rubbish, litter, a confused mass." As a verb Webster defines it, "to search or examine thoroughly by looking into every corner; to create a turmoil or confusion."

Since the lease on the Balsiger Motor company's showroom expired in 1945 and was not renewed due to lack of new cars to show, Elmer Balsiger, owner, has loaned one end of the place to local organizations for rummage sales.

# Brewer Talks Lumber Wage

PORTLAND, Ore., April 29 (AP)—George Brewer, U. S. commissioner who has represented the conciliation service in most of the fir industry negotiations for the northwest, said today he would continue to meet with CIO-International Woodworkers of America and operator groups, now in conference, although he no longer is on the government payroll.

An average of more than 30 rummage sales has been held here in a year, often more than one a week in this one location, and others are frequently held elsewhere in town. Balsiger charges no rental since the organizers are reputable clubs or organizations such as PTA's, churches, women's societies and auxiliaries to lodges, usually raising funds for some worthy cause.

The attraction of a rummage sale may lie in the old secret fascination of a treasure hunt, or in the human hope of getting something for nothing.
