

Shortage Of Egg Cartons Hits Delivery In Basin

Egg cartons, those small pasteboard containers in which your eggs come from market, have practically disappeared from circulation. Local wholesalers have received no shipments for a month and little change in the production situation is in sight. Production will probably not be back to normal until mid year of 1948. So—if you still like an egg with your breakfast toast it may soon be necessary to carry it home in a paper sack or your apron.

Cancer Fund Drive Lags

Klamath county collections for the American Cancer society drive now total \$1664.33. Contributions are continuing to come in, according to Tom Patten and Malcolm Epley, in charge of the drive. They said they hope that enough voluntary contributions will be made within the next few days to complete the county quota of \$2850. Patten is representative of the 20-30 club, which is conducting the drive for the cancer society. Epley is county chairman for the society. The funds are remitted to the Oregon chapter of the society at Portland. Part of the state fund remains in Oregon for cancer control work, and the remainder goes to the national society for research work. The state quota has been topped, according to reports from Portland, although several counties are still below their quota.

Mother Wins Round To Gain Children

SEATTLE, May 15 (AP)—Mrs. Martha Arnesen Busch, Oregon City, Ore., took a long step yesterday in her two-year battle for possession of her sons, Jonathan, 6, and David, 8. Superior Judge Hugh C. Todd held yesterday that the children's removal to Arizona by the father, Ingolf Arnesen of Seattle, was illegal. He upheld the Oregon court's decision to grant custody to the mother, but permitted the father to retain temporary custody pending his appeal to the state supreme court. Arnesen posted a \$5000 bond to insure availability of the children.

School Aid Bill Killed

WASHINGTON, May 15 (AP)—The house republican leadership was reported today to have issued orders to the labor committee to kill a bill which would give states \$300,000,000 a year in federal aid for schools.

A high-ranking party member who does not want his name used told reporters the orders will be carried out because of GOP pledges to hold down government spending. Majority Leader Halleck of Indiana, asked about the report said "there has been no determination on the matter."

Fir Shipments Remain High

PORTLAND, May 15 (AP)—Pacific Northwest Douglas fir areas shipped a weekly average of 135,156,000 board feet of lumber last month—almost

up to the February peak of 146,881,000, the West Coast Lumbermen's Association reported today. Weekly production average was 134,631,000, slightly less than in March. Orders dropped from the March average of 170,535,000 a week to 130,591,000. The association reported gross stocks at sawmills lower than at any previous time this year, indicating that lumber is being distributed

with all possible speed into the normal construction channels. Some 2,203,987,000 board feet of lumber have been turned out so far this year—well above the 1,988,778,000 produced during the corresponding period of 1946. Black rats, fed on nothing but milk, will soon turn gray.
