

Memorial Park Subject Of Debate At Council Meet; Budget Talk Set Thursday

Klamath Memorial Park, the city's new cemetery, came before the city council four times at last night's meetings at the city hall.

First the council acted on a recommendation from the finance committee that the Linkville cemetery fund be combined with the Klamath Memorial Park fund in order that bookkeeping be simplified. The council approved and accepted the recommendation.

Next, the mayor brought up the question of the confusion aroused by the city having two memorial parks, the Veterans' and the Klamath. The members agreed that the matter was confusing and handed it to the city attorney for study.

Later, City Engineer E. A. Thomas, in charge of cemeteries, read to the council two bids that he had received on a lowering device for use at the new cemetery. The city dads okayed one for \$365 from the Pacific Fluid company.

Shelter Asked
This action prompted Mayor Ed Ostendorf to ask the council to have the city engineer construct a shelter for use at the grave sides during stormy weather such as is used at the Salem cemetery. He explained that the latter city had constructed a shelter of sheet metal and placed it on wheels so that it could be towed around the grounds.

Councilman Paul O. Landry asked the mayor what had happened to the canvas shelters that the city had already purchased. Ostendorf replied that they hadn't been used yet, but "weren't very satisfactory." Landry expressed the opinion: "I thought we were going to get away from buying things, then not using them. I think we ought to go ahead and give them a try." The matter was dropped there.

The mayor finally announced that Klamath Memorial Park would be dedicated at ceremonies Wednesday at 4 p. m.

Fund Set Up
Also along the cemetery line, the council passed a resolution setting up the Clara A. Moore Linkville cemetery fund for the upkeep of the latter burial grounds. The fund was created from the gift of \$1000 left by the late Clara A. Moore for that purpose.

Mayor Ostendorf announced that Mrs. Frank Peyton had resigned from the park and recreation committees and he had named Mrs. Howard Barnhisel to fill the vacancy. The council approved the appointment.

Police Chief Orville Hamilton told the council that he would like the police judge to advertise for bids for the new radio equipment which the department hopes to install. He explained that the police radio would have to change frequency under government orders, and the new equipment was for that purpose. His request was turned over to the police chief, mayor and police committee for study.

Budget Meet Set
The much expected discussion of the city budget for the fiscal year 1947-48 failed to materialize and the mayor set a meeting of the council for Thursday at 1:30 p. m. to consider it.

The council also gave its okay for the city to purchase two gas storage tanks, 75 feet of railroad spur and the gate house from the government for the use of the airport.

The fathers also accepted a recommendation of the finance committee that a depreciation list be made up by each department head for each piece of city owned equipment. It was pointed out that the committee would then be better able to anticipate the needs of each department in the annual budget.

"Oregon doesn't claim us," he explained. "Not all wood alcohol is made from wood."

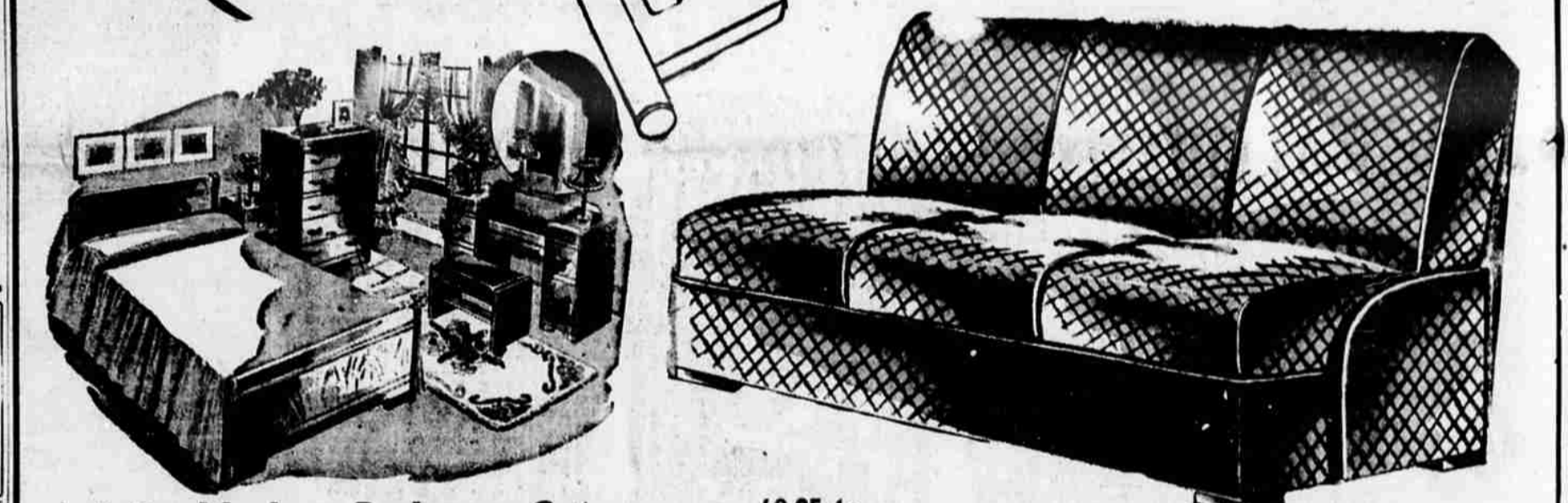
