WASHINGTON, May 29 (AP)—Federal permits will not be required for construction of houses, effective June 1.

Housing Expediter Frank R. Creedon, announcing this today, also said he is lifting then the restriction on number of bathroom fixtures that may be installed in new homes; and is expanding the area limitation from 1500 square feet to 2000 square feet.

Creedon said controls which will be continued include: Government authorization for non-housing construction; veterans preference, which provides a veteran first choice in buying or renting property not intended for the builders' own occupancy; rent ceilings on new construction.
